Someone said recently, "Joy is found in simplicity and generosity." Every day, we see this truth come to life in Haiti. The smiles of children receiving a warm meal, the laughter in a classroom, and the gratitude in their eyes reflect a deep and simple joy, a joy made possible through your generosity.

Trinity HOPE has the privilege of serving meals daily to over 66,500 students in Haiti. This is only possible through God's guidance and your faithful support. Each school partners with Trinity HOPE through a program called Shared Support. When a school joins the feeding program, it agrees to cover a small portion of the food cost, typically around five percent, based on its size and ability. In addition, schools with fifty or more students pay for at least half of their cook's salary, and many cover the full amount. This partnership allows schools to take ownership in feeding their students, teachers, and cooks, and helps Trinity HOPE reach even more hungry children throughout Haiti.

The new school year began on October 1, and enclosed is the first Educational School Correspondence of the year. This correspondence explains more about the Shared Support program and how each school plays a part in feeding its students. You will receive your next correspondence from the school you personally sponsor in January.

Thanks to your generous donations, we are able to continue to feed the hungry bellies and yearning souls. The least of these leave school with full stomachs and higher spirits because they know God loves them.
